CONTINENTAL BEERS

DUPONT (BELGIUM): a brewery located in Tourpes, in the centre of West-Hainaut, Belgium. The current brewery, founded in 1950, is located on a working farm which dates back to 1759 and has significant brewing history.

Saison – ABV 6.5%, 330ml £3.40. Considered a classic among the Belgian saison beers, coppery blond with fine aromas and a strong bitterness transform this beer into a thirst-quencher with no equal.

ERDINGER (GERMANY): Erdinger Weissbräu, located in the heart of Bavaria, is the world's biggest wheat beer breweries. Traditional recipes and modern technology combine to provide "the ultimate in wheat beer enjoyment".

Dunkel – ABV 5.3%, 500ml £3.50. This dark wheat beer is rich and smooth with a chocolaty taste and aroma. It owes its full-bodied flavour to the fine hops and dark malt used in its production.

Kristall – ABV 5.3%, 500ml £3.50. Achieving its crystal appearance from a particularly long filtration process, Kristallklar has a sparkling and refreshing character.

Urweisse – ABV 4.9%, 500ml £3.50. A particularly strong, spicy aroma, a distinctive yeast flavour. The recipe for Urweisse dates back to the brewery's founding days over 120 years ago and uses a special malt, yeast and a different hop variety.

Weissbier – ABV 5.3%, 500ml £3.50. A beer for those who love outstanding wheat beer flavour, the undisputed classic in the Erdinger product range. Brewed according to a traditional recipe and in strict accordance with the Bavarian Purity Law.

TIMMERMANS (BELGIUM): Brewery Timmermans is the oldest Lambic brewery, a family tradition going all the way back to 1702 when Timmermans started brewing Gueuze Lambic in Itterbeek, just a few kilometres from the centre of Brussels.

Strawberry Lambic – ABV 4%, 330ml £3.30. Strawberry flavour without sweetened saturation - a real feeling of freshness. Its taste is consistent and spreads very quickly throughout the mouth to finish on a touch that is fruitier rather than sweetened.

Kriek Lambic – ABV 4%, 330ml £3.30. An immense cherry flavour, agreeably sweet and fruity bouquet - a long lingering taste with a powerful nose.

Pêche Lambic – ABV 4%, 330ml £3.30. A mature beer with a powerful fruit aroma - sweet and fruity flavour with just a hint of bitterness from the peach kernel and skin.

Framboise Lambic – ABV 4%, 330ml £3.30. Faithfully reflecting the colour and flavour of ripe raspberries, with no trace of the acidity. This wonderful flavour reaches its peak with its intensely fresh after-taste.

LA TRAPPE (NETHERLANDS): There are only eight Trappist breweries in the world: six in Belgium, one in Austria, and the eighth, Brewery de Koningshoeven and home of La Trappe, is located in the Netherlands.

Dubbel – ABV 7%, 330ml £3.40. La Trappe Dubbel has a deep, reddish brown colour and attractive beige froth. The use of caramel malt gives it a gentle aromatic caramelised quality. It has a rich malty flavour with a touch of sweetness.

Tripel – ABV 8%, 330ml £3.90. La Trappe Tripel's aroma is slightly malty and sweet. This ale owes its crisp and spicy character to the use of coriander and herbs. Despite its full, rich flavour, it still has a light and dry aftertaste.

ORVAL (BELGIUM): Trappist Cistercian monks of the Brasserie d'Orval produce only one beer, distinctive in its skittle shaped bottle.

Orval – ABV 6.2%, 330ml £3.30. Orval is a very dry, herby beer that is characterised by a bouquet of fresh hops, with a fruity note and pronounced bitterness.
